Ironworkers Local 416 Scholarship Program

1. Only sons and daughters of Local 416 members in good standing or deceased members (who were in good standing at the time of their death) of the International Association of Bridge, Structural, Ornamental and Reinforcing Iron Workers, who are presently in their senior year of high school are eligible to compete for the scholarship.
2. Applicants must be a child, stepchild or adopted child of a member of the International Association and Local 416, who has five or more years of continuous membership in the Association and who is an active member at the time of their child's application. Grandchildren are not eligible to apply. The brother or sister of a scholarship recipient is not eligible to apply within the same year.
3. Applicants should rank in the upper half of their graduating class.
4. Scholarship awards are competitive and will be based on:
 - a. Academic standing of the student during their four years of high school.
 - b. College entrance examination scores (SAT or ACT).
 - c. Extracurricular activities and leadership.
 - d. Character reference and citizenship.
5. A scholarship winner may attend any accredited college or university of his/her choice in the United States and must be enrolled in a full-time program leading toward a degree.
6. The applicant's parent must remain in good standing in the Local for the period of the scholarship.
7. The awards will be made payable to the selected applicants, but will be deposited with the college or university of their choice after they have been accepted for admission. The total scholarship of \$5,000.00 will be made available in \$625.00 awards each semester, assuming two semesters per year and will apply to educational expenses first.
8. The awards will be made for one year and renewed at the start of the following academic year for which the original scholarship was awarded. Whether or not a scholarship shall be renewed will be determined by the Scholarship Committee on the basis of the applicant's scholarship record, conduct and the status of the applicant's parent or guardian.
9. Applicant shall submit a complete application by the last day in June. A decision will be made by the last day in July.
10. In judging scholarship applications, the Awards Committee shall select a list of alternates. Such alternates shall be eligible in the order of their selection of scholarships, in the event that one or more of the applicants should be unable to accept a scholarship award at the time of their initial selection.
11. If the scholarship recipient's schooling is interrupted by either illness or military service, the continuation of said scholarship will be at the discretion of the committee.
12. Prior to changing schools, the scholarship recipient must secure the approval of the Scholarship Committee to insure the continuation of the scholarship.
